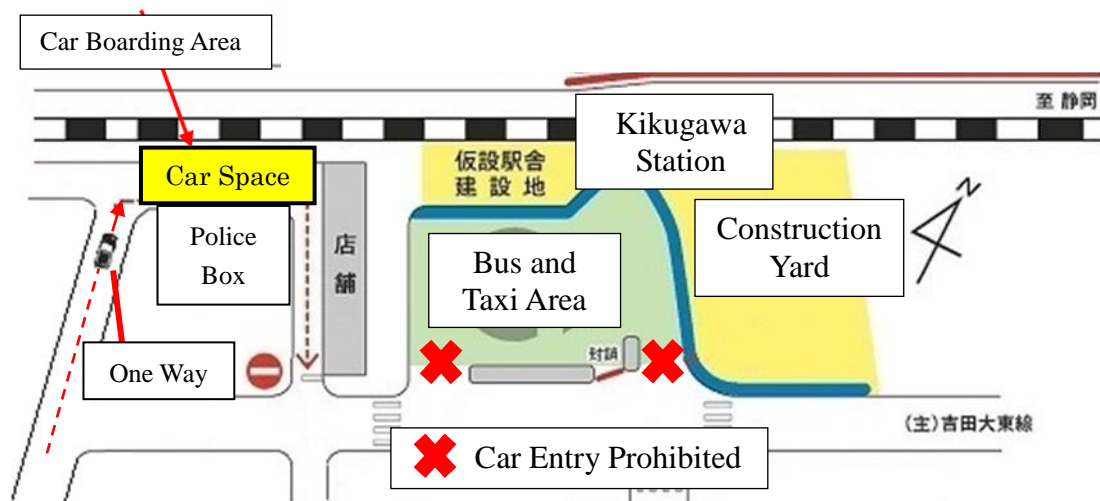


The Station Roundabout Will Be Closed

HPV vaccination is now available as a routine vaccination. A preliminary examination sheet has been sent to those born between April 2, 1997 and April 1, 2007. Those who wish to receive the vaccine should do so as soon as possible.

Vaccination Deadline: March 31, 2025

Things to Bring: The preliminary examination sheet sent to you, your maternal and child health handbook, and the Covid-19 vaccination certificate.

*You may not be able to receive the vaccination on that day if you forget to bring these items.
