Large-Sized Waste Disposal During Obon

Items to Bring When Visiting a Medical Facility

Since December 2024, new Health Insurance Cards are no longer available. When visiting a hospital or pharmacy, use one of the following:

① **Myna Hokensho (My Number Health Insurance Card):** This is your My Number Card registered for use as a Health Insurance Card. You can use it at hospitals and pharmacies as your health insurance card.

※ For registration details, please refer to the Ministry of Health, Labour, and Welfare website.

◆ **Shikaku Jyoho no Oshirase (Notice of Eligibility Information):** This is a document issued to people who use a Myna Hokensho. It confirms your health insurance eligibility. If your Myna Hokensho cannot be used at a medical facility, show this notice together with your Myna Hokensho.

※ This document cannot be used by itself to receive medical care.

② **Shikaku Kakuninsho (Eligibility Certificate):** This document is issued to people who do not have a Myna Hokensho or who are unable to use one. At hospitals and pharmacies, it is used instead of a Health Insurance Card.

✓ **Check this! If you forget to file your Resident Tax Declaration,**
your National Health Insurance Tax may be higher than it should be.

If you do not file your Resident Tax Declaration, the City cannot verify your income. As a result:

1. You may not be eligible for reductions in your National Health Insurance Tax.
2. The maximum amount you are required to pay for medical expenses may not be calculated correctly.

This may result in your National Health Insurance Tax being higher than it should be. If you are required to file a Resident Tax Declaration, please complete the necessary procedures.

Resident Tax-Exempt Households Are Eligible for a Benefit Payment

FY 2026 Resident Tax-Exempt Households are eligible to receive a ¥10,000 benefit payment per household.

When you receive the documents, please review them carefully.

If your household is eligible but you do not receive the required documents by the end of August, please contact the Benefit Support Desk.

【Eligibility】 A household is eligible if it meets both of the following conditions:

- ① All household members are registered as residents of Kikugawa City as of June 1, 2026.
- ② The household is exempt from the FY 2026 Resident Tax per-capita levy.

※ If all household members are claimed as dependents by a relative who is subject to Resident Tax, the household is not eligible.

【How to Receive the Benefit Payment】

After reviewing the notification, please contact the Benefit Support Desk only if one of the following applies: ① You need to correct your tax declaration. ② You do not want to receive the benefit. ③ You want to change the bank account for the payment.
