

- Place in bags designated by the city, and fasten tightly. (Non-designated bags will not be collected)
- Write your full name and the name of your resident's association on the designated bag.
- ■Be sure to check your waste calendar and throw away your trash at your designated area by 8AM of the trash pick-up day or Please bring it directly to the Environmental Resources Gallery.
- •Please bring any waste that doesn't fit in the city approved waste bags directly to the Environmental Resources Gallery.
- Business garbage cannot be sent to the residents' association garbage collection point.

#### Disposing of combustible waste

- ■Throw away kitchen waste after draining it of all water.
- Remove waste before throwing away diapers.
- •Wipe off cooking oil or lotion as much as possible before disposing of burnable waste.
- Always cut long, easily tangled objects such as rubber hoses, ropes, and fishing lines to 1.0 m or shorter.



#### Disposing of Non-combustible waste

- •Cut cords of appliances and such from the base and roll them up before throwing them away.
- •Roll up wires and metal hangers before throwing them away.
- ■To prevent fires during collection, only throw away spray cans after using them up completely and perforating them in a well-ventilated area. Throw away lighters only after using up all the gas.
- Wrap sharp objects such as blades or broken glass in a plastic bag or such before throwing them out.
- Remove the lithium-ion battery.

#### Recyclable Items

#### Dry cell, Rechargeable dry cell

- ■Dry cell and rechargeable batteries will be collected on non-combustible waste days.
- Be sure to place only batteries in the collection boxes located at the pick-up areas.





## Fluorescent lights, Thermometers (Mercury containing)

- ■Pick-ups will be twice a year (Refer to waste calendar)
- Kikugawa City Hall will notify residents of collection dates, times, places, and methods. [Attention]
- Do not break fluorescent lights or thermometers when disposing of them.
- ●Put broken light bulbs in the non-combustible waste.
- Fluorescent bulbs are also OK.

## Plastic Containers and Packaging (Recyclable plastic)

[Container] means...Something that a product is put inside (Covers a bag) [Wrapper | means...Something that becomes unnecessary once it is detached from the product, when the product is consumed, etc.













Laundry detergent. Shampoo and Lotion containers.

#### **Rules**

#### At home

- Please do not leave any leftover food or product.
- •Wipe off or lightly rinse off anything stuck.
- It is OK if there are paper stickers attached.



#### When taking out

- Remove contents from the bag, separate them, and place them in nets.
- Fasten bags tightly before disposing of them.








#### on non-combustible waste days

- Rusted or corroded items cannot be recycled. Please put them in the non-combustible waste.
- Please separate all aluminum and steel cans.
- Please do not crush cans or PET bottles that will go in city recycling.
- Dispose of plastic lids and PET bottle labels as plastic recycling.
- Please clean inside before disposal.
- Bottles with leftover drinks or garbage such as cigarette butts inside cannot be recycled.
- Dispose of items that cannot be cleaned as combustible waste.








- All bottles will be separated by color into clear. brown, and other.
- Clean insides thoroughly before recycling.
- Bottles with leftover drinks or garbage such as cigarette butts inside cannot be recycled.
- Dispose of ceramics, glass dishes, cups, and heat-resistant containers as non-combustible waste.
- Bottles can be recycled even if they are broken.
- ■Empty bottles of pesticides or flammable liquid will not be received. (Inquire at the original place of purchase or outlets for hard to process items.)

#### Styrofoam trays (white only)



- Rinse and dry before throwing away.
- Remove all stickers, label, etc.
- Natto containers go with the plastic containers and wrappers.

#### Permanent collection base for recyclables (Akatsuchi Recyclestation)

Will take recycable items for free that did not get to be put out on collection day.

#### 2. Warnings

- •Wrap newspapers, magazines, and cardboard with a paper string, and collect miscellaneous recyclable paper in an old envelope before disposing of it.
- Shredded paper is not accepted.

#### **Collection of Old Clothes**

To promote the effective use of recyclable cloth and reduced combustible waste, the city of Kikugawa collects old clothing.





## Disposal of waste from home medical care

Please beware of special methods for disposing of waste produced by at-home medical treatment.

- •Injection needles, tubes with needles, etc. used at home should be returned to the relevant medical agency or pharmacy. (The city cannot handle them.)
- Syringe barrels without needles, tubes, catheters, IV/nutrient packs, gauze, rubber or plastic gloves, etc. should be placed in a transparent bag, and put in the city approved waste bag for combustible waste.



◆Please inquire with a medical institution or the City Hall Environmental Promotion Division for how to dispose of other waste produced by at-home medical treatment.




#### Instructions for directly disposing of waste.

- Please dismantle and separate furniture, mattresses, and zabuton cushions.
- Any objects dismantled or removed by a construction worker, carpenter, etc. is considered industrial waste and cannot be thrown away. Please inquire at the Industrial Waste Association. (TEL.054-255-8285)
- Please check all waste and place in the appropriate designated waste bag and drop it off at your local waste pick-up area.
- ◆Place small amounts of grass and tree branches (5 waste bags or less) in designated bags, and put out for collection in your district.
- Please separate combustible and non-combustible waste before bringing them in.
- Be sure to remove all kerosene from stoves and heaters.



## Regarding disposal of appliances falling under the Electric Appliance Recycling Law



Disposal methods for electronics subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Law are as follows.

(A recycling fee is required).

- ①Hand over the old appliance to the store when buying a new replacement.
- ②When disposing of an old appliance without buying a replacement, if you know where it was purchased, please bring it there.

In regards to ② and ③, if you do not know where the old appliance was purchased, please take it to a consumer electronics recycling center, or purchase a recycling ticket in advance at a post office and bring it to Shizuoka Daikyu Unyu (KK) or the Kankyo Shigen Gallery.
